RALLY FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE LEAVE

Violence against women has claimed 52 lives since a COAG summit last October recommended paid leave for people affected by domestic violence.

Yet nothing has been done.

Unions will today continue their campaign to have 10 days of domestic violence leave included in the National Employment Standards.
