**More work to do to resolve rail crisis**

The Combined Rail Unions today met with NSW Minister for Transport Andrew Constance in a further attempt to resolve the continuing dispute between rail workers and the NSW Government.

Unions NSW Secretary Mark Morey said it was promising that the Minister was at least prepared to listen to the concerns of workers.

“The Minister acknowledged that the NSW rail network is carrying more passengers than ever before.

“This has been achieved in no small part due to the hard work and productivity of Sydney Trains and NSW Trains employees.

“This acknowledgment is a start, but more work is required to see this reality reflected in an Enterprise Agreement that delivers a fair outcome for workers, and a safer and more reliable rail service for commuters.

“We have agreed to continue working over the weekend and to meet again on Monday to try to resolve this dispute.”
