International Women's Day March and Rally in Sydney TOMORROW

Thousands of women will rally in Sydney's Hyde Park to stand up against sexual harassment and violence against women TOMORROW (Saturday, 10 March 2018).

In the past 12 months 51 women have been killed by violence. At the same time the Federal Government has privatised the national sexual and domestic assault hotline 1800 RESPECT and refused to provide women with access to paid domestic violence. High-profile revelations of workplace sexual harassment has shown the extent of violence in women face, and women are standing up to say enough is enough.

Women will be protesting on Saturday to say End the Silence, End the Violence - at work, at home and on campus.
